CONTINUITY OF EDUCATION PLAN Western Area Career & Technology Center

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Western Area Career & Technology Center will provide educational instruction and enrichment to all of our students through on-line platforms or by printed materials mailed to those students who do not have internet access.

- Weekly lesson plans will be sent out to students each Friday with a deadline date weekly.
- Teachers and Paraprofessionals will be available to answer questions via school-issued email or telephone during regular school hours.
- Teachers will use a variety of teaching methods (i.e., Google Classroom, Zoom, CDX, NCCER, You Tube and Quizlet).
- Printed materials will be mailed out weekly to those students who do not have internet access.
 - Printed materials will be for five days.
 - Teachers will check on students weekly.
 - Paraprofessionals will work with any students that may need help.
 - Paraprofessionals have been assigned to technologies to enable them to work 1:1 with students that have an IEP.
 - Technical assistance will be available during normal school hours for any students who are having difficulties.
 - Communication via website will be available for students and parents.
 - Administration will monitor all activities and enrichment programs.
 - A Google Classroom has been set up for teachers to enable administration to monitor and/or answer any questions.
 - Daily updates are made to this chat room by administration.
 - Grading will be on a Pass/Fail basis so that all students do not fall behind when school returns.
- Since theory can be done online or with packets provided to all students when/if we return in the fall, all students will be doing performance-related tasks. Hands-on projects will make up for about 90% of the students grade. Students will work on live projects and will supplement their education with distance learning. Instructors will determine appropriate projects that will help students achieve certifications and complete the Program of Studies (POS).
