● How long is the course?

WACTC is offering the Emergency Medical Technician program as an evening program. You will attend Tuesday and Thursday from roughly 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM for (23) Twenty-Three weeks or a total of 180 hours of instruction.

The course is considered the minimum requirement to meet employment certification requirements as an Emergency Medical Technician. Students who successfully complete the course will be eligible for NREMT credentialing exams for EMT Certification.

■ How much does it cost?

WACTC is a non-profit institution, so we really try to keep our costs down. The daytime option is \$1,100.00. Financial aid may be available to those who qualify. We have financial experts on staff to assist you in the process.

Are there job opportunities for me when I'm finished?

An emergency medical technician (EMT) is trained to respond to emergency situations and perform lifesaving techniques until a patient can be transported to a hospital or treatment facility. Many are also responsible for the safe transfer of patients via ambulance from the scene of an accident or sudden illness to the closest medical facility. Unfortunately, in today's world, our local community is a facing a real crisis, with opioid addiction. Our local communities all need well trained first responders to meet the call.

COURSE OBJECTIVE:

Students who successfully complete the course will be eligible for NREMT credentialing exams for for EMT Certification.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The EMT course provides a basic foundation for emergency care and prepares an emergency responder to intervene in a medical trauma emergency. The students will develop the ability to comprehend, identify and illustrate the skills knowledge gained through applied practice sessions and exercises. The instructor will measure each student's outcomes through classroom observations, verbal interactions and written examinations.
